Cost and Insurance Coverage

Clover Genetics is focused on the utilization of telehealth to improve access to genetic counseling and holistic healthcare. We offer several payment options to cover the cost of our services:

Self Pay - Out of Pocket (OOP)

We offer initial genetic counseling appointments scheduled for one hour and billed at a rate of \$300. Follow-up visits may be shorter and will be billed based on our current fee structure. Visit our website to learn more. Prior to your appointment, please ask if you would like to set up a payment plan or require financial assistance.

Paying with HSA or FSA

Genetic counseling and testing services qualify for use of your HSA (Health Savings Account) or FSA (Flexible Spending Account).

Insurance

Many insurance companies provide coverage for genetic counseling and testing. Clover Genetics does not accept insurance for genetic counseling services, however, we can facilitate the billing of insurance for genetic testing services completed through our practice. We are always available to provide assistance and explanations!

Financial Assistance

How Do I Prepare for My Appointment?

Knowing your family's medical history helps you get the most out of your genetic counseling session.

Prior to your intake, please collect the following:

- Personal medical history
- Health history of both maternal and paternal blood relatives
- Grandparents, parents, aunts/uncles, first-cousins, siblings, children, grandchildren
- If you've had any major biopsies or surgeries, a copy of the clinical or pathology report
- Results of any previous genetic testing (yours or blood relatives) if possible
 - Important details: year of the test, lab name, genes tested, test result
- A copy of your insurance card and/or payment method

The Importance of Family History

Family history is crucial in assessing risk of inherited and genetic medical conditions. By researching and recording your family health history, you are taking the first step in learning your risk for different medical issues so that you can continue working with your healthcare team to manage any increased risks.
